Code of Conduct

All members of MKSB are required to follow our Code of Conduct. These basic rules are designed to ensure harmony, growth, cooperation, responsibility and respect among our membership.

A select group of club "Elders" assigned by the "Manager" will oversee the development and compliance thereof as well as actions taken in the wake of any violations of the Code of Conduct, but generally-speaking, any significant or repeated violation of any Code of Conduct rule is grounds for termination of membership from MKSB as well as withdrawal from any club-related activities or ventures.

1. No Illegal activities

Members refrain from any activity which may be against local, state or federal statutes, including but not limited to use of illegal drugs, software piracy, unauthorized computer hacking, possession of stolen goods, or fraud of any kind.

2. No un-ethical activities

Members agree to act honorably towards other members as well as the general community, especially when representing the club in any manner. No lying, deception or inappropriate exploitation of others. Honesty and a member's words carry great weight within our ranks.

3. Show respect for oneself and fellow members

Members agree to carry themselves in a conscientious and respectful manner. Members agree to always show respect towards other members, as well as respect each others' privacy, identity and possessions. NOTE: There is a difference between respecting a person and being forced to respect their particular ideological or philosophical identity. You do not have to agree with someone's beliefs, but you must respect their right to believe something other than what you believe. The cornerstone of our group's unity lies in our open-mindedness coupled with mutual respect.

4. No un-authorized visitors, non-members or guests are allowed at club functions without approval

MKSB is a private group with a protected membership. Excepting public venues or other public events or gatherings where it is clearly understood to be open to non-members, no member shall bring any guest, visitor or non-member to a gathering or venue without advance approval from the Elders. When members open their homes and other venues for access by club members, the property owner has the exclusive right to determine who has access to his/her resources and unless otherwise specifically noted and approved, anyone bringing a guest to any of the members' properties must seek prior approval. This includes non-member children, spouses and family members of anyone other than the property owner. Please seek permission before bringing non-member guests of any kind.

- Members follow “Better Than Before” policy and pledge to protect, preserve and improve themselves, the club, its projects, its resources and its members’ resources.

As members make themselves and their resources available to the club, fellow members agree to show great respect and consideration for each other and the resources, materials and property they offer to fellow members. This means you treat others’ property as if it were your own.. or better. Members are responsible for cleaning up after themselves, removing trash, and generally leaving equipment and property in better condition than they found it. Members will help restore and maintain various club resources including pinball and arcade machines, meeting places, etc. Anything broken or damaged will be replaced by the member who caused the damage. In the case of pinball machines and other equipment that may wear or break through normal use, members agree to promptly report such situations to Elders to be taken care of. Members will not continue to use any item that may be damaged, whereby continued use may cause further damage (i.e. if there is a problem with a game, don’t keep playing it and exacerbate the issue, instead report it and mark the game out of order).

- Members keep club business private

While it’s ok to make reference to our club’s existence, its name and brand information, its charter, its public activities and general nature, without specific prior approval from Elders, members shall not publicly or privately reveal to any non-members, certain details including: descriptions, dates and locations of members-only meetings and events, dues and any club-related financial data, club-related alarm, passwords or access codes of any kind, address of any club resources or club member property locations, detailed lists of club or member property, disparaging comments about members or the club, or non-public/personal information on any fellow members. In general, the club’s meeting locations are non-public information and should never be advertised publicly.
